Saint Polycarp

Feastday: February 23

Polycarp was a holy man and bishop of Smyrna. One day, during a bloody martyrdom, the crowd became so mad that they demanded more blood by crying, "Down with the Christians; let Polycarp be found. Polycarp was persuaded to leave the city and hide.

While praying he saw a vision of his pillow turned to fire and announced to his friends that the dream meant he would be burned alive. His pursuers found him by torturing two boys. The proconsul begged the eighty-six-year-old Polycarp to give up his religion to save himself, Polycarp answered, "If you imagine that I will swear by Caesar, you do not know who I am. Let me tell you plainly, I am a Christian."

Because of Polycarp's lack of fear, the proconsul told him he would be burned alive. When he was tied up to be burned, Polycarp prayed. The fire was lit as Polycarp said Amen and then the eyewitnesses who reported said they saw a miracle. The fire burst up in an arch around Polycarp, the flames surrounding him like sails, and instead of being burned he seemed to glow like bread baking, or gold being melted in a furnace. When the captors saw he wasn't being burned, they stabbed him. The blood that flowed put the fire out.

On February 13th, 14th, and 15th Our Lady of Lebanon hosted the Regional Retreat for the MYO groups in the Midwest. Over 60 youths attended and participated in various activities.
