### St. Bernard of Clairvaux

Born in France, St. Bernard was the third of seven children. He spent his youth frivolously but decided to go into the religious life on the death of his mother.

He became a Cistercian abbot and legendary speaker who fought for the peace and unity of the Church against schism. He had an amazing capability for learning quickly which brought him renown outside the monastery. He wrote many treatises on the Blessed Virgin and Jesus Christ, as well as many works of theology and ascetics. His life manifested a profound recognition of the importance of obedience in one's spiritual life.

St. Bernard was considered to have so much wisdom and learning that he became one of the most well-know and consulted people in Europe. Many miracles were attributed to him and he was known as one of the greatest preachers of his time.
