The Father

“Our Father Who art in heaven...”

Why do we call God that?

We say, “Father” as though He is human. Shouldn’t we give Him a **non**-human name...like the American Indians did: “Great Spirit”? Or why not play it safe and simply say: “God”? Or call Him “Creator”...which would certainly describe what He does?

But if we really need to use a human name, why not “Mother”... or “Parent”?

Even if we admit we live in a patriarchal, male-dominated society there are other masculine names that we could use. What about “Warrior King” (guys should like that), or the feudal “Lord”, or “Just Judge”? all very descriptive and apt titles.

But from Bible times right up to today, we always say “Our Father”. It’s what Jesus and Paul called God. When they addressed Him that way, what do you think they intended?

Well, we know the New Testament used the Aramaic word “Abba” for father which is very intimate, something like “daddy”. It is usually translated as **THE** father.

To the first century biblical mind, **A** father was provider, protector and model of good behavior for the family. But **THE** father was more than that. He was the householder who took care of not only the wife and kids. He took care of everybody on his property: brothers and sisters, clients and dependents, unmarried females and out-of-work males, animals, lands, even tools used.
