## What am I doing for Lent this year?

Dear Parishioners,

Allow me to begin by thanking you for your kindness and support to the Church, your second home, during the Christmas and Epiphany Seasons and to our Special Events. Your outpouring of love and support as well as your generosity is truly overwhelming. May God reward your generosity many times over.

### LENTEN FAST AND ABSTENENCE REGULATIONS:

It is now time for us to begin our Lenten season. This Monday will be Ash Monday, and the Church recommends that all people ages 14 to 65 fast and abstain from meat and meat products on all Fridays of Lent. Fasting and abstinence from food and drink except water and medicine is demanded from midnight until noon on Ash Monday and Good Friday. Those unable to fast because of health are required to perform an act of charity.

As we know, the traditional purpose of Lent is our preparation, through prayer, penitence, almsgiving and self-denial, for the annual commemoration during Holy Week of the Death and Resurrection of Jesus.

Prayers, Fasting and performing works of Charity are three words we have to take into serious consideration during this season. What my plans for renewal this 2010 Lent? Do I need the Bible to accomplish my Lenten goals? What am I doing to calm my spirit and to ask for God's help? What about the sacrament of Reconciliation? Should I wait longer to clean my conscience and heart and renew my relationship with God, others, and myself? Every sin, no matter how private, affects others. Fasting will soften your heart for charity and quiet your spirit for prayer. Don't forget, we receive more by giving than by having.
