

St. Maria Goretti

Feastday July 6th

St. Maria Goretti was born in Corinaldo, Italy, on October 16 1890. By the time she was six, her family had become so poor that they were forced to give up their farm, move, and work for other farmers. Maria's father became very sick with malaria, and died when she was just nine. On July 5, 1902, eleven-year old Maria was alone sewing when an eighteen-year-old neighbor, Alexander, grabbed her from her steps and tried to rape her. She would not submit, however, protesting that what he wanted to do was a mortal sin and warning Alessandro that he would go to Hell. When Maria said that she would rather die than submit, Alexander began stabbing her with a knife.

Maria's little sister Teresa awoke with the noise and started crying, and when Maria's mother came to check on the little girl, they found the bleeding Maria and took her to the nearest hospital. She underwent surgery without anesthesia, but her injuries were beyond the doctors' help. Twenty hours after the attack, having expressed forgiveness for her murderer and stating that she wanted to have him in Heaven with her, Maria died of her injuries, while looking at a very beautiful picture of the Blessed Mother.

Alexander was captured and sentenced to thirty years. He was unrepentant until he had a dream that he was in a garden. Maria was there and gave him flowers. When he woke, he was a changed man, repenting of his crime and living a reformed life. When he was released after 27 years he went directly to Maria's mother to beg her forgiveness, which she gave. "If my daughter can forgive him, who am I to withhold forgiveness," she said.

Maria was declared a saint in 1950. Alexander was there in the St. Peter's crowd to celebrate her canonization. She was canonized by Pope Pius XII in 1950 for her purity as model for youth. She is called a martyr because she fought against Alexander's attempts at sexual assault. However, the most important aspect of her story is her forgiveness of her attacker -- her concern for her enemy extending even beyond death. Her feast day is July 6and she is the patroness of youth and for the victims of rape
