Start by Judging Myself!

The tongue as well as any other organ is a small part of the human body, but has great potential for either **good or evil**. **Our speech reveals who we are. Our action reveals our faith and behavior.** People **learn about us** by listening to what **we say** and they **know us** by knowing what **we do**. We become familiar with people through the same medium. But, our life becomes fairer when we put **Jesus' words in practice**: *“Do not judge and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven”*. But how can we understand or accept the last judgment in the readings of this Sunday? Jesus answered this question in Mt 12:36: *“For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned”* or in Mt 16:27 *“For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with His angels; and then He shall reward every man according to His works”*.

God is not judging us, but our **words and actions will do it**. God is Love and Love is grateful. We will be judged for our **lack of love** toward Him, others, and ourselves.

Still, we have also to thank the people who are gracious toward us. Why do we always look on them in a negative way? Those people **contributed differently in our life**: they could be our parents, our children, our neighbors, the cook at the restaurant or the server, the salesman or my priest. Do I thank God for what they are doing for me? We **can not be indifferent** all the time. We don't have to wait to show our gratitude.

Don't wait to tell your loved ones that you love them. **Don't wait** to help, to support, to assist, to comfort, to console, to give, to forgive and to love. **Do it today**, especially as maybe tomorrow will never be, or it could be the day in which you will be judged for today. *Whatever we do for one of the least of these brothers, we do it for Jesus.*
