The Church Prays the Creed ... Pay Attention



Every Sunday at Mass we recite the Nicene Creed. It is the Church's official Statement of what we Catholics believe. I've said the Creed so often and I know the words so well that its easy, for me, to sort of "sleepwalk" through it.

So, OK, I'm now going to concentrate. I'm going to pay attention to the familiar words. Let's see. The first part is about God the Father "Maker of heaven and earth ...

That's clear enough. The second part concerns Jesus: "...for us men and for our salvation He was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake, He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, He suffered, died and ..." ... wait a

minute!

Did I skip something?

Jesus was born ... and in the very next sentence He's dead! There's a big jump from the beginning of Jesus' human life to it's end. It seems to me that there's a huge gap where Jesus should be.

Why doesn't the creed proclaim the human deeds of our Lord? ...what He said, His miracles, His association with sinners? What about His opposition to the religious establishment of the day? I'd like to state my belief in social justice.

But the Creed ignores all that. The fact that a first century Jew spoke in parables, forgave sinner, welcomed strangers doesn't seem to interest the Creed writers at all.

Saint Domnina of Syria

Feastday: March 1

Saint Domnina of Syria, also known as Domnina the Younger, was a fifth century ascetic. Her name is mentioned in the Byzantine Synaxarium and according to Theodoret, Bishop of Cyrrhus, Domnina was born to a rich Syrian family.

She became a disciple of Saint Maron.

As a young woman she constructed a straw-covered hut made with millet stalks in the garden of her mother's house, located in Kyra near Antioch. She passed all of her life there. She only ate lentils soaked in water to the point where she became extremely thin and went to church in the morning and in the evening. Domnina covered her face in a veil so that no one could see her face. She had 250 female followers, who passed the time doing manual labor and "assigning their hands to card wool, and consecrating their tongues with hymns."

Her voice, in the words of her biographer Theodoret of Cyrrhus, was "resonant and expressive, and her words were always accompanied by tears. Theodoret writes, in his *Religious History*, that Domnina acquired such a state of religious ecstasy that she could not speak without weeping as she was considered to have been inspired by the love of God.

She died between 450 and 460 AD. Her feast is celebrated March 1st.
